Content	Students will analyse an extract from the Victorian text they're currently studying ('A Christmas Carol' or 'Jekyll and Hyde') and write an essay based on it. For example: 'How does Dickens present charity in this extract and the wider novel?'/ 'How does Stevenson present Hyde as a fearful character in this extract and the wider novel?'				
Preparation Resources	 Use your exercise books and copies of the novel to revise the plot, characters, context and a few key quotations. Revise key critical vocabulary and how to use it to discuss themes. The writing section is a piece of narrative or descriptive writing in response to an image.
